Key wins

- The Breede Valley Municipality committee launched a community-based ECD campaign to register unregistered centres and improve data accuracy. The initiative aimed to register all unregistered centres on the e-Cares system and update the municipality's ECD database. This approach reduced logistical barriers and created a platform for efficient data capture and system alignment.
- Recent meetings and events have yielded positive outcomes, with a site visit to 12 ECD centres using the Mazi tool providing assistance and clarity. Meetings with Inceba Trust, Sikunye, the Department of Health, Sarie and Hettie Pool Charitable Trust, and Word Works have explored ways to enhance community-based initiatives, including improving child health and learning outcomes, and gathering feedback on ECD centre support visits.
