

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


STEP ONE

The child must put their finger on the column or over all the blocks in column, the same can be repeated for the other clothing items.






STEP ONE

Put the colour Question Cards into the left side margin, ask the child where the purple cards will go, they must place their finger along the row; do this for each of the colours.

STEP ONE

Hold up one the answer cards, ask the child what it is. They must tell you the colour and item type.

STEP ONE





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STEP ONE

Begin with all the cards on the board. Tell the child to listen carefully and give you the card you ask them for. Begin with 2 cards.

Early Learning Facilitator (speaks)

Give me the Brown pants and purple dress.





STEP ONE

If successful, the child may move onto giving you 3-4 cards.

Early Learning Facilitator (speaks)

Give me the Brown pants, Orange shirt and Purple dress.





STEP TWO

Hold up the brown Question Card, ask the child to give you any card that has something in it such as cards that have brown in them, or cards that have a dress on etc.





STEP TWO

Ask the child for cards that don't have certain traits such as cards that don't have a dress on or cards that dont have orange etc. When the child has selected them correctly, return the cards to the board.





STEP TWO

If successful, repeat the exercises with different Answer Cards, such as cards that dont have shorts or a dress etc.





STEP TWO

Ask the child to give you a card that is NOT brown, NOT black and NOT purple, but has a dress (orange dress), Repeat using 3 different colour to exclude and a different object.





STEP TWO

Ask the child to give you a card that is NOT pants, NOT a dress and NOT shorts, but is purple (purple shirt), Repeat using 3 different objects to exclude and a different colour.
